

Gulfstream Park Vaccination Requirements

All racing animals must be vaccinated for Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes Virus (the "RhinoFlu" vaccine) pursuant to Chapter 61 D6.009(a)2 of the Florida Pari-Mutuel Wagering Rules. Entries will not be taken on those horses which the trainer has not provided current vaccination information. All horses stabled on the grounds of Gulfstream Park, GPW, and Palm Meadows Training Center must be vaccinated at minimum of twice yearly. Trainers are responsible for maintaining at their barn, and submitting to the racing office, current vaccination records on all horses in their care. Vaccination records of claimed horses must be transferred by the previous trainer to the claiming trainer within 24 hours of the official transfer of ownership.

Each horse seeking entrance into Gulfstream Park, GPW, and Palm Meadows Training Center stable area shall:

- a) Be accompanied by a current Coggins test result
- b) Be accompanied by and listed on a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) which has been signed and dated within (72) hours of arrival by a licensed veterinarian, and shall contain the following written statement:
 - a. "The horses listed on this Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) have not originated from, nor has had Herpes Virus (EHV-1) diagnosed during the previous thirty (30) day period.
- c) Have been vaccinated against Equine Herpes Virus Type 1 (EHV-1) by a licensed veterinarian within a minimum of fourteen (14) days and maximum of ninety (90) days prior to entry. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) shall also indicate the date of the vaccination and vaccine product used to vaccinate each horse.

*Horses that arrive at the Stable Gate without proper documentation will not be granted access. Only horses arriving directly from GPW and Palm Meadows Training Center to race are excused from requiring a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for admission.

ALL HORSES must have a valid Coggins with a date that carries at least through the end of the current meet. For horses stabled YEAR ROUND at Gulfstream Park, Gulfstream Park West or Palm Meadows Training Center: Every horse must have a valid Coggins with a date that carries at least through December 31 of the current year. The simplest way to achieve compliance is to pull all your Coggins in early January.
