He returns in a spot where he should have a class edge, as he is taking a significant drop in class after a disappointing performance last time out. That was also a race in which he got warm before the race, and did not break well, while the winner sat a perfect trip behind a good pace. Wigwam Summer has won races both on the lead and coming from behind, and I think he should be successful against this field.

LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #7 Chop Chop Charlie

I'm expecting the strongest race from this gelding today, as he is making his third start for this barn and third start of his current form cycle. Two starts back, in his first race in Florida, he had a very troubled trip and can absolutely be forgiven the poor performance. Last time out, he ran a solid race, beaten three and a half lengths. I think he can be a bit more forwardly placed today, and meets the right field at a good price.
