However, he had a pretty rough trip, having to steady repeatedly, and yet was only beaten by two lengths for third. He is now second off the layoff, as well - a high percentage move for this barn. He should get a ground saving trip from the inside post and is pretty tactical.

**LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #9 What's Inside**

It looks like there is plenty of pace signed on in this race, and What's Inside should sit a great trip. His last race was disappointing and at a big price, but he is switching back to the dirt today, which clearly looks to be his preferred surface. His race two starts back, although on a wet track, was a strong effort with an 80 Beyer Speed Figure. He has some solid back form on a fast main track and we'll see if he can repeat that performance second off the layoff today.
