She has some tactical speed, too, and that should serve her well in a race where the pace scenario is a bit murky.

LONGSHOT: Race 8 - #10 City Roc

His last race was not pretty, that's for sure, but today City Roc is switching back to what appears to be his preferred surface. Pretty much all of his races going 5 furlongs on the turf have been solid performances, including his race two starts back where he finished a good second. He gets a more aggressive rider in C C Lopez in the saddle today, and while he has been searching for that elusive second career victory for a while, he certainly has the potential to run well and grab a share in here.
