**BEST BET: Race 4 - #4 Concealedwithakiss**

This mare is an eleven-time winner in her career, and five of those wins came right at Gulfstream. She comes back on a quick turnaround, having just raced six days ago, but that last outing was in the G2 Princess Rooney where she was in over her head and stumbled at the start and never really ran a step. Back in a spot where she will be comfortable, she outclasses this field and also has the tactical speed and a notable jockey change to Jaramillo.

**LONGSHOT: Race 8 - #1 Controlled Fury**

This two-year-old son of Jimmy Creed is debuting with a strong pedigree, as the mare won at first asking and progeny of this freshman sire are 4-for-10 so far, and also features Admiral Jimmy, who finished third in the Tremont Stakes. Controlled Fury debuts with a sharp worktab and gets Lasix right off the bat, plus Leo Azpurua Jr. is 4-for-11 with \$5.65 ROI with two-year-old first time starters.
