With a good outside post, there is plenty of speed to her inside to run at, and is hoping for a cleaner trip than what she had to deal with last time out in the Mary Todd.

**LONGSHOT: Race 10 - #8 Discovered**

It's true that this horse is going to have his work cut out for him facing winners for the first time, but I expect an even more improved effort than his last now that he is making his third start off the layoff. That said, he got the win to break his maiden last time out, even though he was still green and drifted in the stretch. He has a tactical running style, and the 78 Beyer Speed Figure he earned for his maiden score should absolutely make him a contender.
