After shipping in from California, Tell Me a Story made his first start for the Casse barn at GPW and did so with a daylight score against \$20,000 claiming types. Now protected and not in for the tag, this gelding will try to repeat that 83 Beyer Speed Figure, which certainly makes him the class of the field. He has tactical speed, and should be in the right place.

**LONGSHOT: Race 5 - #6 Ed's Rocket**

Although he hasn't shown much in the latter stages of his first two races, this 2-year-old looks eligible to show more and will be a good price. He is a fresh gelding, and should be fresh, as he has been working steadily at GPW since his last start on September 30. In a race with lots of questions, Ed's Rocket could certainly take a step forward.
