BEST BET: Race 1 - #4 Majestic Mist

Last time out at Suffolk Downs, this filly did not show quite as much early speed as she has previously. It seems she's a better horse when on the lead, as can be seen by her Saratoga win two back, which was also off of a layoff. It's possible she regressed a little last time, but she should be able to get back on her feet and control the pace in the opener.

LONGSHOT: Race 7 - #8 Rickey's Girl

While Rickey's Girl may not be up to par with some of the other contenders in this race as far as Beyer Speed Figures go, she comes out of a key race against tough allowance company at Delaware Park, where she had a very eventful trip. Additionally, her last start was going 9 furlongs, and she'll get the turn back to the mile distance today. Given her running style, this should suit her well. Hot-riding Emisael Jaramillo has the call.
