However, that stake produced three next out winners, and the second place finisher, Kowboy Karma, was 4th in the G1 Champagne in his subsequent start. With a couple local works at PBD, I'll give this colt another chance.

LONGSHOT: Race 10 - #6 Calypso Deep

Making his second career start, this 2-year-old gelding will try the turf for the first time after a pretty disappointing dirt debut. However, that was on a sealed sloppy track, and he had traffic trouble, having to check back very sharply. While the dam never won on turf, Calypso Deep is the half-brother to stakes placed Mis Pardner Rules, who was a grass winner.
