BEST BET: Race 8 - #1 Thinkin Cowtown

This daughter of Cowtown Cat is a very big, sizable 4-year-old filly with a powerful late run. Unfortunately she lost any chance last time out when she was bumped back at the start of the race and her jock lost his iron. Today, she should be able to pull a ground saving trip from the rail and should have pace to run at going her preferred distance of 5 furlongs.

LONGSHOT: Race 7 - #2 Midnightonbroadway

Although he just broke his maiden and is facing winners for the first time, this 3-year-old gelding has a versatile running style and has been very good in his two starts sprinting. In addition, with maiden winners last time out sprinting on the dirt, the Orseno barn has a 20% win average and a positive ROI of \$3.67.
