**BEST BET: Race 12 - #6 Fully Loaded**

True, anything can happen with the two year olds, but Fully Loaded has been very impressive and is undefeated in his two career starts, now ready to face stakes competition in the Florida Sire Dr. Fager. He is reminiscent of trainer Jose Pinchin's star Three Rules, who swept this Florida Sire Stakes series two years ago. He also showed multiple dimensions, wiring the field last time, but coming from off the pace to win his debut race.

**LONGSHOT: Race 8 - #7 Homedrill**

This horse will be a big price after a non-effort first time out, but I think we will see a much improved effort today. I like that he already has experience going two turns on the turf, and he has a strong pedigree behind him. Plus, trainer Mark Casse has good numbers with 2-year-olds making their second start on the turf in maiden special weight races, batting at a 23% win average with 52% finishing in the money, and an ROI of \$2.15.
