**BEST BET: Race 8 - #1 Electric Forest**

Audible is likely the free bingo square and box office star for many on this Saturday card, but from a betting standpoint I prefer Electric Forest as my best bet. She is facing some more seasoned horses in the G3 Rampart and some of serious back-class, but this filly's last race in her first start against older horses was as impressive as it could be. This one mile distance should suit her perfectly, and I expect good things from her in her second start off the bench.

**LONGSHOT: Race 6 - #5 Glorious Mystery**

The drop in class should be key for this filly by Gone Astray, who has run some solid races in her three race career so far. She is coming off a nearly four month layoff, having not started since August, but picks up jockey Irad Ortiz Jr. and the blinkers come off for trainer Jose Pinchin. I like her here at what will likely be a nice price.
