LONGSHOT: Race 7 - #3 El Commendatore

His only grass race to date was against special weight company, and since has been running for maiden claiming. By Giants Causeway and out of a mare who was a multiple graded stakes winner and three-time turf winner, this gelding also has four siblings who won on grass. The pedigree is there and the competition level should be good.
