Not to mention, she is now second off the layoff, a move which, on the turf, trainer Reid Nagle wins at a 22% clip out of a sample size of 68 horses, finishing in the money 56% of the time with a \$2.83 return of investment. She was used early last time out with not much to offer in the stretch, and I think she'll show an improved effort today.

LONGSHOT: Race 10 - #1 Swapl

On paper, this looks like a race with a fair bit of speed signed on, and, while shopping around for a logical closer, Swapl seemed to fit the bill. She is perhaps not the most consistent mare, but her race last time out was very encouraging as she came running with a strong close. At a nice price, she could even grab a piece of the pie if not the win.
