He has also been training very well leading up to today and is making the third start of his current form cycle.

LONGSHOT: Race 8 - #2 Mr. Sultana

Mr. Sultana is a getting a slight turn back in distance from the seven furlongs to the six and one-half furlongs, and this should suite him well. He can sit a good stalking trip, but is versatile and has also shown in the past that he can win on the lead. He has some dirtied up form, and that should ensure he is a good price come post time.
