LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #6 Chasing the Stars

I think that the biggest plus for this gelding is the drop in class for a good, and sometimes under the radar, barn in Monte Thomas. Getting in light with apprentice Romero Ramsay Maragh in the saddle, this horse has already shown that he is versatile and can come from off the pace or be up close if need be. In a race without a clear pacesetter, I think that this will suit him very well.
