BEST BET: Race 3 - #4 Kroy

This horse exploded onto the scene last year at Gulfstream, and has been fun to watch, even adding "graded stakes placed" to his resume at the end of 2017 when beaten just half a length in a G2. First off the layoff, the connections opted to try him on dirt, and while still finishing a good second, I think turf is his preferred surface. With a race under his belt, he should be primed today.

LONGSHOT: Race 6 - #3 Grace B

More than anything, I think the turn back to a sprint distance will be very beneficial for this filly, who has had a tough time since exiting the maiden ranks. After trying slightly tougher competition, she dropped to this level last time out and finished a solid fourth after showing some speed. Given her resume sprinting and her natural speed, I think she should be a good fit in here at a nice price.
