BEST BET: Race 2: #1 Scuba Sue

Trainer Resharn Creque has a very good record with winners last time out on the turf (4-for-12 over the past 5 years).

LONGSHOT: Race 6: #5 Halfback

In a race where some solid runners might be overshadowed in the wagering, Halfback gets blinkers on and onto a fast main track again. In his last race, he finished fourth behind eventual G2 Rebel winner Malagacy, who blew the field away to win by five lengths. There are gaps in between his two career starts, but he's been working steadily and gets Edgard Zayas for his return.
