LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #8 Brahms Cat

One of two stakes on today's card, the Musical Romance is a very competitive field. Brahms Cat does have to improve after her most recent effort, but she'll stick at the seven furlong distance once again and has quite a bit of back class. She was third in the G2 Forward Gal during the Championship Meet, and most recently was fourth in the Game Face, a race which produced a next-out winner in Actress, who went on to take the Black Eyed Susan Stakes.
