He has won his last two races, both at GPW, and on his Beyer Speed Figures and his consistency, he looks to be the class of the field. We'll see if he can keep the streak going.

LONGSHOT: Race 10 - #5 Nicky's Warrior

This filly debuted on the turf against slightly tougher competition, and her last two races have been taken off the turf due to weather. She has a turf-winning sibling, and did show some late rally on the grass in her first start. Trainer David Fawkes bats at about 25% with 2-year-old maiden claimers going from dirt to turf, and this one should be in the right spot.
