**LONGSHOT: Race 2 - #4 Kalama**

Making his second career start for trainer Sandra Slivka (who has two in here), this 2-year-old gelding will try the grass for the first time. While the dam never ran on turf, she has produced two foals who have won on the green, including stakes placed Trev. Luca Panici stays up.
