BEST BET: Race 10 - #9 Spring Up

This gelding is 4-for-9 here at Gulfstream Park, and is returning now to the track where he has had quite a bit of success. First off the claim for trainer Armando De la cerda (a very productive move for this barn), Spring Up is getting some class relief, and perhaps most importantly, has a good closing kick in a race that appears to have a fair amount of speed signed on. He's been training very well over the deep Gulfstream Park West surface in preparation for his return to the races since July 21.

LONGSHOT: Race 8 - #12 Force

The outside post will definitely be a hurdle for this horse to overcome, but since he is a closer, I am not as concerned about it and feel that jockey Samy Camacho should have ample opportunity to let him settle back and make a late run. After a relatively long winless streak, this 6 year old finally got back to the winners circle last time out, and I'm hoping that his confidence will remain high after this recent victory. He is stepping up against open claimers now, but he has plenty of back class to call on.
