She was on the bench from December to July, and returned to the races with a strong second and her highest Beyer Speed Figure to date. I expect an even better run from her today second off the layoff.

LONGSHOT: Race 1 - #2 Gia Lia Joe

Trying to get a price home early, I think this filly meets the right field today to get her maiden score. She ran okay last time out at this level on the grass, despite the fact that she drifted out at the start. She gets a strong rider in Miguel Vasquez up today, and I think that he will fit her perfectly. She's also making the third start of her current form cycle and should be primed.
