LONGSHOT: Race 3 - #10 Third Man In

Although this will be his first start on conventional dirt after having run exclusively on the synthetic up at Woodbine, he is coming in off of a string of strong performances. He finished in the money in his last four races, and was beaten just a nose last time out. This is a very sharp barn, that had quite a bit of success during last year's Championship Meet with horses shipping in from Woodbine.
