BEST BET: Race 8 - #7 Madison Blues

When running against slightly tougher competition last time out, Madison Blues ran a very good second behind a tough horse and in-form foe in Feed Me Carats. Now dropping back in for the \$10,000 tag, I think she is exactly where she fits. Since moving to the barn of Jose Pinchin, the only blemish on her form was when she took a bad stumble three starts back and the rider lost his iron. She's been very consistent.

LONGSHOT: Race 10 - #7 Reagan's Rose

I'm taking a stab with Reagan's Rose here because I think she has the right running style to get the perfect pace setup in this race. She has been a closer lately, and that should suit her well given that there is so much speed in here. There's a chance the pacesetters just get away from the rest of the field, but this filly should be able to at least grab a piece. In addition, this is now her second race on the turf, and in her first grass try she was only beaten two lengths. Emisael Jaramillo stays aboard.
