BEST BET: Race 3 - #7 Loving Valentina

The blinkers go back on as this filly gets ready to make her second start off the claim for trainer Peter Walder. She's been fun to follow, as she seems to always run to her competition and overcome adversity. She's been quite popular at the claim box recently, so I think making her second start for a high percentage barn we should see a stronger effort than last time. In addition, she's stretching back out to the mile distance and should be forwardly placed.

LONGSHOT: Race 4 - #9 Drinks On Maggie

This filly will be racing on the main track for the first time, but trainer Yvon Belsoeur has very good stats with this move, albeit with a small sample size. Going from turf to dirt with horses second off the claim, this barn is 2-for-5 winning, and 3-for-5 in the money with a \$4.08 ROI. Drinks On Maggie is by Stay Thirsty and I always thought she had the look of a horse that could run on either surface. She also has natural speed and an outside post.
