After an open length victory last time out, it looks like trainer Elizabeth Dobles has Arty'sbourbongirl staying in top form. Beaten two back by the Pink Mama (who was on a 6-race win streak), this five-year-old mare is a six-time winner out of 28 starts, and has a lot of natural speed.

LONGSHOT: Race 8 - #8 Roses in the South

Both logical favorites in this race for the two-year-old fillies have their fair share of questions, so perhaps a first time starter could be dangerous. Out of a stake placed mare who has already produced a foal who won 8 times sprinting on the dirt, Roses in the South had a very nice work on July 22 for trainer Larry Bates and will debut with Lasix.
