I usually don't like to single in a lower level claiming race, but this gelding looks to be a big standout on paper. Making his second start for top connections, he gets a turn-back in distance, and it looks as if sprinting might actually be what he prefers. Jockey Tyler Gaffalione is also in town this weekend and has the call on this gelding by Tale of the Cat.

LONGSHOT: Race 11 - #11 Drama in the Rain

The wide open nightcap might see most of the wagering dollars going to the Mike Maker-trained Streak of Kitten, who was well bet first time out, but beaten by 31 lengths. This very well could be the horse to beat second time out, but I preferred her neighbor, Drama in the Rain, who ran a good race at this level last time out and has been freshened since May 10. She's tactical, and has been training very well since her last start.
