BEST BET: Race 4: #1 Hy Brasil

This Malibu Moon colt debuted on April 15, and I have been waiting for his return to the races. He made an excellent physical impression in his first race, and backed that up with a respectable third place finish. Coming off a bullet work at Palm Beach Downs, he should be ready to navigate the rail post in this small but potent maiden special weight field.

LONGSHOT: Race 8: #9 Seven of Jack

There is question as to whether bettors will get the 20-1 morning line odds on this horse, but if so, it's worth a bet. One of two in here for Victor Barboza Jr., Seven of Jack was a strong fourth last time out after getting off to a slow start. He earned a 70 Beyer Speed Figure for that performance going seven furlongs, and should be a little more forwardly placed on the stretch out to a mile.
