BEST BET: Race 3 - #8 Nonno Nino

LONGSHOT: Race 4 - #2 Indian Myth

First off the claim for the high percentage barn of Victor Barboza Jr, Tapete Claire, who won last time out, will likely take all the money in here. I think that, at a price, Indian Myth is a filly that will offer nice value. She is 0-for-13 this year, which of course is her glaring negative, but she has natural early speed and has been consistent, and I think she can hit the board at double digit odds.
