LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #6 El Commendatore

This is a nice 2-year-old field on the turf, and this Joe Orseno-trained first time starter might be a nice price in a wide open affair. The pedigree for the grass is certainly there, as El Commendatore is by Giant's Causeway and out of a multiple graded stakes winning mare who was a three-time turf winner. In addition, this colt is the full brother to multiple stakes winner and multiple graded stakes placed Giant Run.
