**LONGSHOT: Race 10 - #11 He's a Leader**

This 2-year-old's form on paper is dirtied up enough that he will definitely go off at a fair price come post time. He comes out of the same race as three other horses in this field, and had a nightmare trip with trouble both leaving the gate and in the stretch. There's plenty of turf pedigree on the bottom side, and will make his third grass start here for a very sharp barn.
