LONGSHOT: Race 2 - #1 Salsa Capuchino

This horse is one of those that always seems to be ignored in the wagering. Double digit odds in his last two starts, he ran a very good second last time out despite being wide, and two back had a nightmare trip when having to check sharply. He fits at this level and will likely be a nice price in a field where everyone has their own fair share of questions.
