LONGSHOT: Race 4 - #8 Treatherlikestar

Turning back in distance to one turn today, it looks to me like this is the preferred spot for this filly. Her races sprinting - on both turf and dirt - have been her stronger ones in my opinion, and she also has some tactical speed. She has to prove herself at this level on the turf, but given her consistency and the way she has run against optional claiming types recently, I think that she fits just fine here, and will be a nice price.
