BEST BET: Race 9 - #4 Cordele

Although beaten by another horse in this field, Cordele has a troubled trip last time out and still finished a solid third. Trainer Brendan Walsh does an excellent job of keeping horses in top form, and this filly seems to be very well spotted in this field. She's been incredibly consistent on the turf, with her most recent race being her only defeat on the grass.

LONGSHOT: Race 11 - #3 Harlan's Quest

With yet another rematch of the outside horses Tu Exageres and Diamond Mint, I think these two will take most of the money and you'll get a fair price on a fresh face like Harlan's Quest. Getting a significant class drop for trainer Jane Cibelli, this gelding keeps Irad Ortiz Jr. in the saddle, and will also turn back to one turn. He's 2-for-4 at this distance, and has the running style that should suite this 5/8 on the Gulfstream turf.
