**BEST BET: Race 5 - #1 Rogue Patriot**

First off the claim for Victor Barboza Jr., this horse seems to meet the right field to get out of second gear. Normally, I'll stay away from a horse who has been consistently finishing in the money, but this barn is very potent off the claim on the dirt with horses who were in the money last out (41%) and he should sit a good stalking trip from the inside post under Irad Ortiz Jr.

**LONGSHOT: Race 8 - #11 The Money Train**

This horse definitely has some dirtied up form, but that should make him a great price in here. Adding blinkers after a couple races run too far off the pace, this gelding also gets an important drop in class and gets a rider more on the aggressive side in Emisael Jaramillo, who should fit him well. He broke his maiden here at Gulfstream, and I'm hoping he can recapture some of that form.
