BEST BET: Race 7 - #2 Super Spender

I have been chasing this horse in his last few starts, and while it has been a while since he's seen the winners circle, I'm hoping he gets some better racing luck today. Two back he was stuck with an impossible outside post in the Claiming Crown Canterbury, which was won by top sprinter Pay Any Price and has proved to be a monster key race. Last out, he was stuck 7-wide in the stretch with absolutely no place to go. He should get some pace to run at today.

LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #1 Hangry

This will be a real litmus test for how productive the 3rd race on January 21 was, as it was won by an 80-1 shot in a 4-way photo, which included Hangry and Indian Scout, who is also in this field. While Indian Scout is 9-2 on the morning line, Hangry will be a much bigger price and his late-closing running style might fit even better in this field, which seems to have a fair bit of speed signed on. I think jockey Miguel Vasquez handles this horse well, and he stays aboard today.
