It looks like this filly has really made it clear that the dirt is her preferred surface. She does have a win on the grass, but her best races have been on the main track, and she even showed last time out that a track with some moisture in it was no problem when she won going 7 furlongs by three lengths. She has a nice tactical running style and has shown in the past that she can put back to back wins together.

LONGSHOT: Race 6 - #7 Forty's Sweetheart

More than anything, the drop in class will be key for this filly. She meets a solid field today, but has been running against significantly tougher competition lately. If you look through her past performances at the last time she ran at this level, she has three races for the \$6,250 tag, which were a pair of second place finishes and a win by 7 and 3/4 lengths. Back in a spot where she can be successful, she will be a much better price than the last time she ran at this level.
