His performance last time out in the Carry Back was nowhere near as strong as his run two starts back in the Ocala Flame, but the surface was listed as wet fast last time and it's possible he didn't handle the going, combined with the tougher company.

LONGSHOT: Race 4 - #4 Love Flute

On paper, it looks like there is quite a bit of speed signed on, and in shopping around for a closer, this mare fits the bill. It's true that she has been running at slightly lesser levels lately, but she's consistent as well as versatile, and I think she'll sit a good trip. She comes out of a key race that produced two next out winners, and has been working extremely well since her last start at the end of May.
