This horse is best when he can use that powerful closing kick, and he should have pace to run at with the presence of the speedy Small Fortune to his outside and Billy the Bull to his inside.

LONGSHOT: Race 4 - #4 Puertorican Style

First time in the barn of Tammy Levy, a very sharp claiming outfit, this colt is looking to keep the momentum going and make it three in a row. This will definitely be a step up in class for him, but he keeps Irad Ortiz Jr. in the saddle off the barn switch, and has been very good in his last two with a tactical running style. He's also been working very well at Gulfstream Park West since moving to his new surroundings.
