**LONGSHOT: Race 5 - #1 Dealer's Girl**

Switching back to the turf, which clearly looks like her preferred surface, Dealer's Girl looks primed today. Although trainer Kelly Breen has only run two horses so far this meet, he finished with a first and a second, so clearly the record has been good. This filly has plenty of natural early speed and two wins at this distance.
