**LONGSHOT: Race 7 - #6 Friendswith K Mill**

In a tough claiming race on the grass, a horse like Friendswith K Mill might be overlooked in the wagering with some of the other big players in here. However, after switching back to the turf last time out, we saw an improved effort from him with a very good third place finish. In addition, there does look to be enough speed in here to keep the front-running Weeza Gone Gray honest, and that could set up for this 6-year-old gelding's running style.
