**BEST BET: Race 5 - #3 Susikin**

It's true that anything can happen with 2-year-olds, but this filly looks awfully tough in here. She won at first asking and did it on the turf, and that race turned out to be a key race with two next out winners, including one of her opponents, Towa. She keeps Emisael Jaramillo in the saddle, and is getting ready to make her second career start for trainer Victora Barboza, who is batting at a jaw-dropping 45% in 2018. In addition, this filly trains right here at Gulfstream Park West, which is a deeper track, and the works have been very good.

**LONGSHOT: Race 4 - #6 Artist**

Though well beaten as the favorite last time out, I think this horse has a chance to move up today. Two starts back (at the same class level) he ran a good second behind a repeat winner, and now he is first off the claim for trainer Angel Quiroz, who is about 22% with this move. In addition, hot-riding Paco Lopez will be in the saddle today.
