There are certainly questions about with this 3-year-old son of Put It Back, but there also appears to be quite a bit of upside and at a nice price. For one, he only has two starts in a field full of long-time maidens. Making his first start for trainer Dave Kassen, he gets a significant drop in class and comes out of a turf race that produced four next out winners. Let's see if he can improve here.
