She gets Emisael Jaramillo in the saddle today for that stretch out of the extra half a furlong. She showed speed last time out, but came from off the pace in her debut with a good late kick.

**LONGSHOT: Race 1 - #9 Uncommon Factor**

On paper, this filly did little to no running in her first race. She was bumped by her neighbor at the break, and then hustled up towards the front of the pack, as she was quite rank and hard to control. Her rider did the right thing in keeping her outside of horses, but given the amount of energy she expended in the early part of the race, faded quite quickly. Now that she has some experience under her belt, she is getting a drop in class from maiden special weight to maiden claiming. The third place finisher from her debut race also came back to win next time out.
