Additionally, there is plenty of early speed in here, and she should be in the catbird seat.

**LONGSHOT: Race 6 - #5 Party Tarde**

It's not often that you can find a Gilberto Zerpa/Emisael Jaramillo combination at a good price, and yet this filly might be just that with some other players in this field. Her maiden win came after a significant class drop and on a wet track, but she ran very well in her fast track claiming race on 3/2. Could be live her.
