BEST BET: Race 9 - #7 My Life

My Life showed promise in his debut with a strong second place finish at Gulfstream Park West back in November, but then got off to a slow start in special weight company in February. The drop in class last time saw him much more forwardly placed, and it appears that the added blinkers (plus an additional class relief) should put him on or close to the lead this day. That speed will be his best weapon in this field.

LONGSHOT: Race 6 - #8 Sassy Slew

This will be the first time racing on a fast main track, but Sassy Slew debuted in a state bred maiden special weight event that is turning out to be a huge key race, producing three next out winners. The drop in class and the addition of blinkers should aid this filly, who also comes in off a very sharp four-furlong work on April 8 over the Gulfstream main track.
