She looks on paper to be the controlling speed in here, and jockey Nik Juarez should be able to dictate the pace. She's stepping up in class, but won so impressively last time out at GPW that it looks like a vote of confidence that she is not in for a tag today.

LONGSHOT: Race 7 - #6 Cut to Order

Switching back to the turf and turning back in distance, my initial thought was that one mile might be a bit too short for Cut to Order, given that his last grass race was going a mile and a half. However, he is 4-for-9 at this distance with one second place finish. Trainer Armando de la Cerda reaches out for leading jockey Luis Saez and this gelding should get a perfect trip in here.
