BEST BET: Race 10 - #5 Clear for Action

This colt by English Channel has done some OK running in his career, but he gets a significant - and needed - drop in class today, and has plenty of natural early speed. Trainer Mike Maker and owners Ken and Sarah Ramsey are known to simply put horses where they can win, and that looks to be the case here with Clear for Action. He's also coming off a bit of a freshening since December 23, and will make his second South Florida start since shipping down from Woodbine.

LONGSHOT: Race 1 - #11 Mohanie

This horse didn't do any running last time out, but it was against significantly tougher and her first time on turf, along with her first time against open company. This New York-bred filly gets a drop in class today, and hopefully will get out of the gate better this time, as she was off slowly in her most recent outing. The blinkers were also added last time out, so today she will have the experience under her belt after all of those changes. I expect a much improved effort from her today.
