Stanley Gold appears to have this 2-year-old primed for this spot.

LONGSHOT: Race 3 - #1 Monkey Money

Although his last win was on a sealed sloppy track, this is a gelding who is in very good form. His most recent race was going to turns on the turf, and that does not seem like his best spot. Monkey Money has proved himself to be much more effective going 5 furlongs, and that's what he'll do today. Apprentice jockey Aby Medina has been riding in very good form lately.
